Sealed Bids for the 2017 Street Resurfacing Project will be received by the Village of Cridersville at the Village Office, 110 W. Main Street, Cridersville, Ohio 45806, until Tuesday, March 14, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. local time, at which time bids received will be publicly opened and read.

In general, the project consists of pavement planing, asphalt overlay, and full depth repair on various streets and alleys within the Village.

Neither Owner nor Choice One will be responsible for full or partial sets of bidding documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than Choice One.

Bids must be signed and submitted on the separate bidding forms and sealed in a properly identified envelope.

The project will be awarded contingent upon OPWC approval which is expected on or around July 1, 2017. Work may not begin until after this date.

The bid security shall be furnished in accordance with Instructions to Bidders.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the Equal Employment Opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

DOMESTIC STEEL USE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE APPLY TO THIS PROJECT. COPIES OF SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ANY OF THE OFFICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES.

Bidder must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Auglaize County and the Village of Cridersville, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Bureau of Employment Services, Wage and Hour Division, (614) 644-2239.

No Bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 60 days after the actual opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed by Owner to be most favorable to the Owner.
