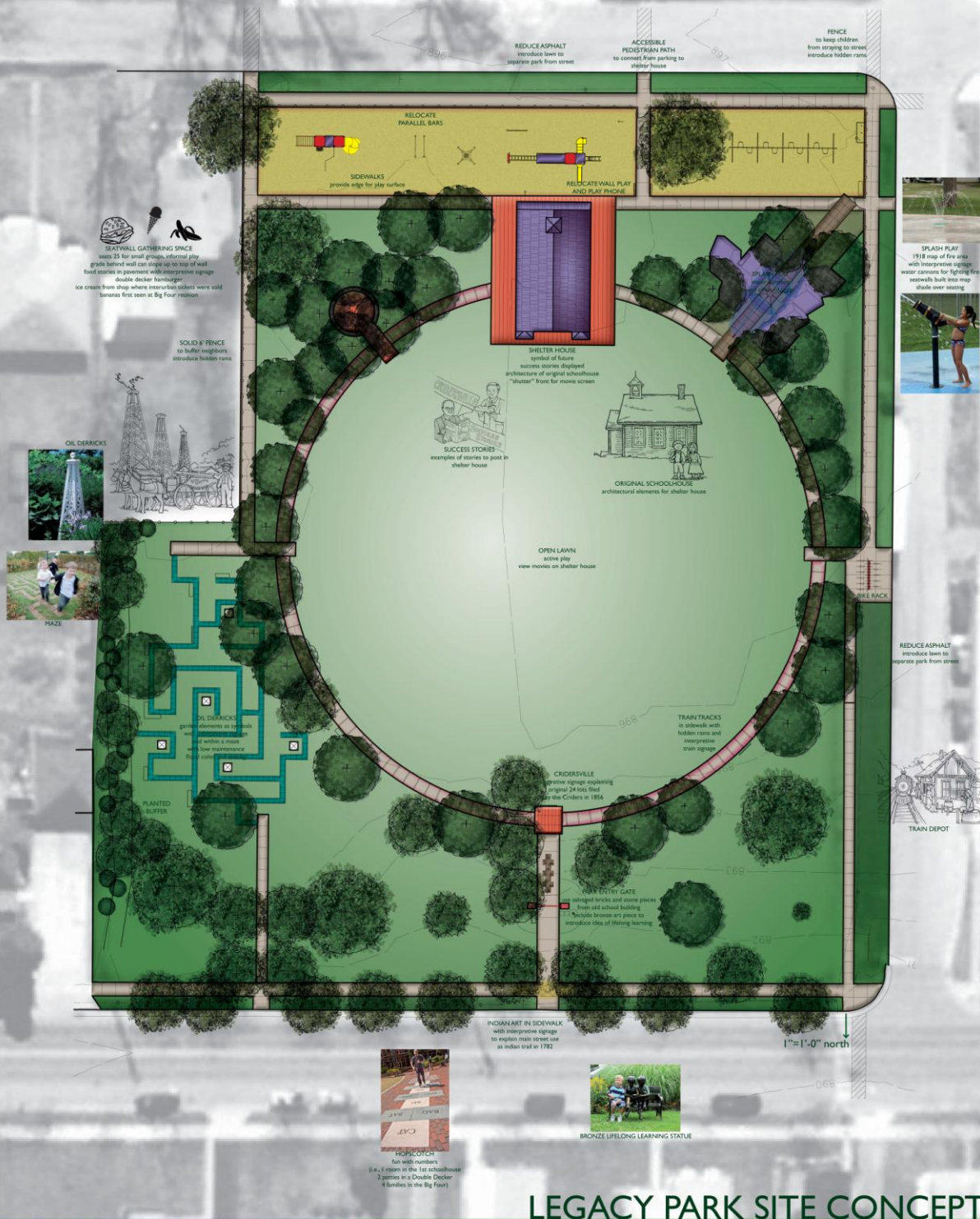


HIDDEN RAFTS

with donor names



SEATWALL GATHERING SPACE
uses 25 for small groups, informal play
grass behind wall can edge up to top of wall
food service in pavement with interpretive signage

bananas first seen at Big Four reunion

REDUCE ASPHALT
introduce lawn to
separate park from street

ACCESSIBLE PEDESTRIAN PATH
to connect from parking to
shelter house

FENCE
to keep children
from straying to street
introduce hidden crane

RELOCATE PARALLEL BARS

SIDEWALKS
provide edge for play surface

RELOCATE WALL PLAY AND PLAY PHONE

SHUTTER HOUSE
shelter play
symbol of future
success stories displayed
architectural elements of original schoolhouse
"shutter" front for movie screen
