

|  <p>Glass</p> | <p>Bottles and Jars in Clear, Brown, and Green colors. All lids must be removed from the glass. We can recycle only container glass, no ceramics, cooking glass, window glass or auto glass.</p> |
|  <p>Cans/ Foil</p> | <p>Aluminum cans, tin and steel food cans. Please separate aluminum from other cans. Aerosol cans that are empty are also acceptable. Aluminum foil and pie pans are acceptable. We accept scrap steel, but we do not purchase it.</p> |
|  <p>Cardboard</p> | <p>Please breakdown all boxes to use less space in transportation to processing center. * Cereal type boxes should be placed with mixed paper. *</p> |
|  <p>Mixed Paper</p> | <p>This is the newspaper, slick ads, phone books, office paper, paper board (Cereal type boxes), magazines, cartons, office paper, paper bags, and envelopes. *Please empty all paper out of all plastic bags.</p> |
|  <p>PETE</p> | <p>This is the pop and water type containers.</p>  |
|  <p>HDPE NATURAL</p> | <p>This is the frosty type containers such as some milk and juice containers.</p>  |
|  <p>HDPE COLOR</p> | <p>This is the soap and detergent type containers of any color.</p>  |

|  <p>Cooking Oil /Grease</p> | <p>Used cooking oil and grease is now being accepted only at 15502 St. Marys River Rd. St Marys, Ohio</p> |
|  <p>Holiday Lights</p> | <p>Any old light strings, can have bulbs in them.</p> |
|  <p>Bags</p> | <p>Plastic Bags are accepted. However, you must empty all materials in their proper location before depositing the plastic bags.</p> |
|  <p>Vinyl Siding</p> | <p>Vinyl Siding is now being accepted, however, it MUST be cut into 4' sections before dropping the material off. Absolutely no metal or nails. It will only be accepted at 15502 St Marys River Rd, St Marys, Ohio.</p> |
|  <p>Batteries</p> | <p>Household Batteries ONLY, there are charges on 12V, 6V, etc. Car Batteries and standard household batteries are free of charge.</p> |
|  <p>Tires</p> | <p>Tires are accepted with an associated charge. They are considered part of the household hazardous materials.</p> |
|  <p>E-Waste</p> | <p>Computer/Computer Equipment (Keyboards etc.), CD players, Cell Phones, Home Telephones, Remotes. Televisions are accepted but there is an associated charge.</p> |
|  <p>Motor Oil</p> | <p>Please bring in with containers of five gallon size or smaller. This allows personnel to handle this product easier.</p> |
|  <p>Shoes</p> | <p>Must be paired together. No rubber type rain boots or shoes with heels over two inches.</p> |
