Sparky the Fire Pup will be making an appearance along with a puppet show. There will even be a balloon artist walking the midway creating most anything you could imagine.

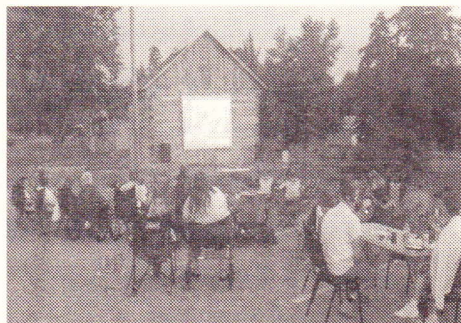
There is a **Ride Special** on Saturday 2:00 to 5:00 with all you can ride for only \$12. Also

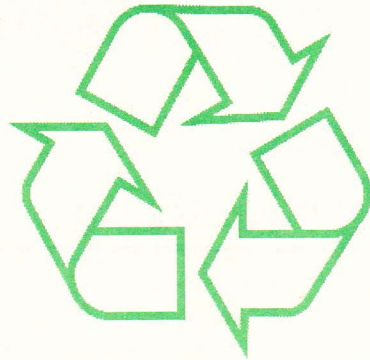


## Calling All Desserts

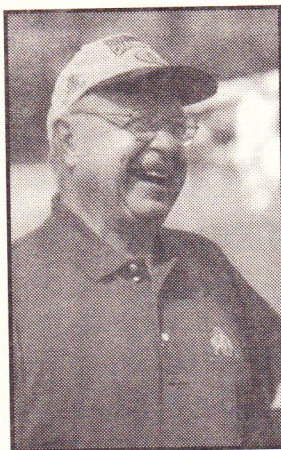
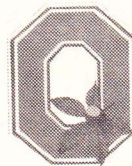
