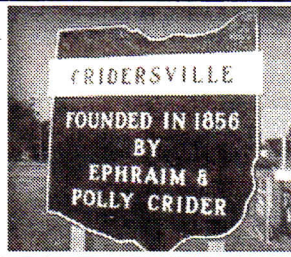

We are looking forward to seeing you at the 48th Annual Jamboree. We also hope you will have a great time eating, talking, and socializing with friends and neighbors.

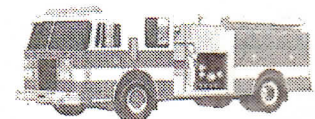

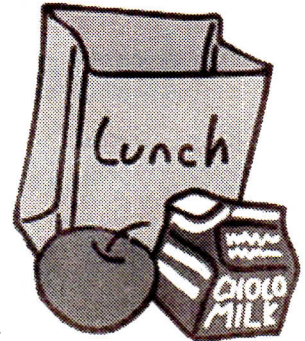

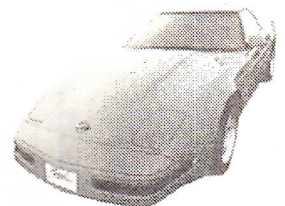

Summer Time Reminders

Did You Know Cridersville has a noise ordinance and a curfew for anyone under 18?

With summer upon us, many people are out in the yard with the stereo on or driving around with the windows down and the radio turned up. Please remember to be courteous to your neighbors and keep the volume down. If your music is too loud you could face up to a \$150 fine.

Village officials also want to remind parents that there is a curfew in the village for anyone under the age of 18 years old. The curfew for anyone 15 years and younger is 10:00 p.m. unless they are with a parent. Anyone age 16 and 17 have a weekday curfew of 11 p.m. and a weekend curfew of Midnight unless with a parent.

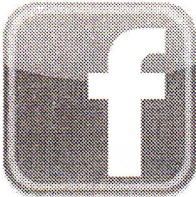
