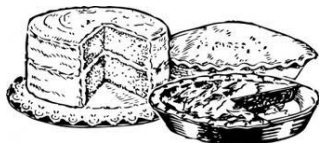

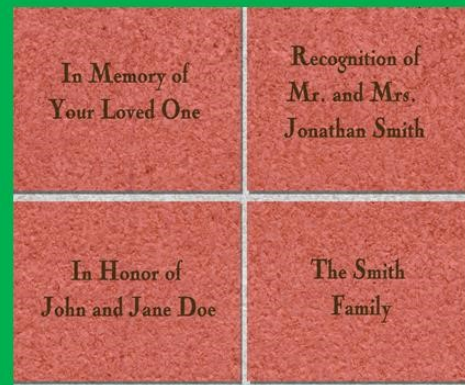

Cridersville Recycle at Tower Park

The recycle center is managed by the Cridersville Lions Club as a community service. The club relies on volunteers to work the monthly manned Saturdays sorting the dropped off recycle. During the rest of the month residents can drop off certain items in the chutes. Chutes are marked for specific items such as mixed papers, 1 pete and 2 hdpe. When using the 24 hour drop off please make sure you use the correct chute. Example recycle items have been placed on the designated chutes. The recycle placed into the chutes doesn't get sorted by anyone but you. The club would also like to remind you that the trailer is for cardboard only. It must be corrugated cardboard not paperboard. Paperboard such as pop and beer cartons, cereal boxes, and paper towel rolls go in the mixed paper chute. Please help us recycle properly to maintain the recycle center.
